



- CUCFs application was approved through Operation Warm, we partnered with LEADS HeadStart and Hope Center to provide shoes and coats to 450 children. Awaiting delivery.

MSY Funding

• Currently have 1 youth utilizing MSY funding from ODM for residential treatment, we applied for an addition \$13,875 after the initial 90 days request to fund estimated return home in mid-January.
